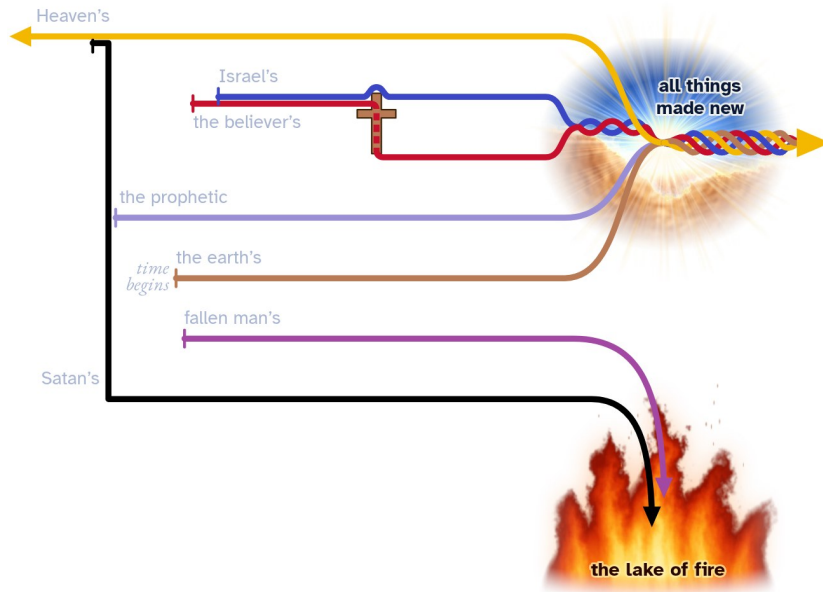


Seven timelines, two endings



History does not run on one track. Heaven, Israel, believers, the empires of prophecy, the earth itself, fallen man, and Satan each have a line of their own in Scripture. They do not all end in the same place.

The chart draws the seven side by side so you can see what is happening on each at the same moment. The book follows the same seven twice: once through the age we live in, and once through the seven years of the tribulation.

Watch where the lines go. From the return of Christ, Israel's line and the believer's are woven together. At the end heaven's line and the earth's meet them, and the four are woven into one where all things are made new. The prophetic line ends there, because by then every word of it has come to pass. Fallen man's line and Satan's go down to the lake of fire. Choose a line to follow it on the chart, or a chapter to see its subject there.
